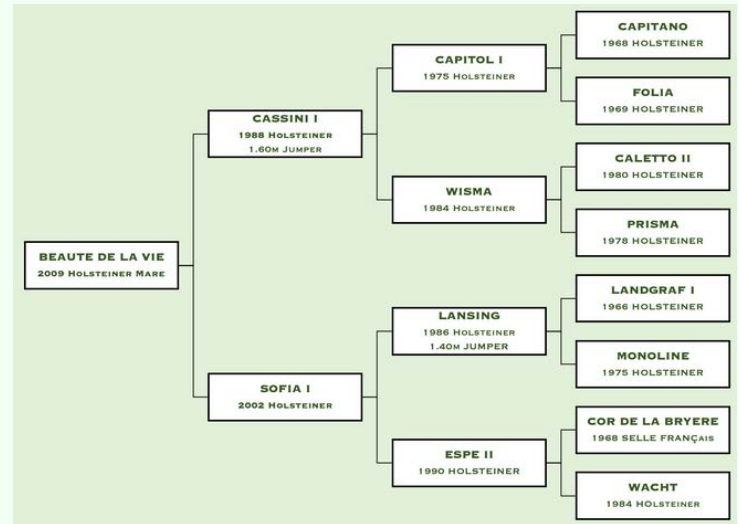

# Beauté de la Vie DKS (Cassini I-Lansing))

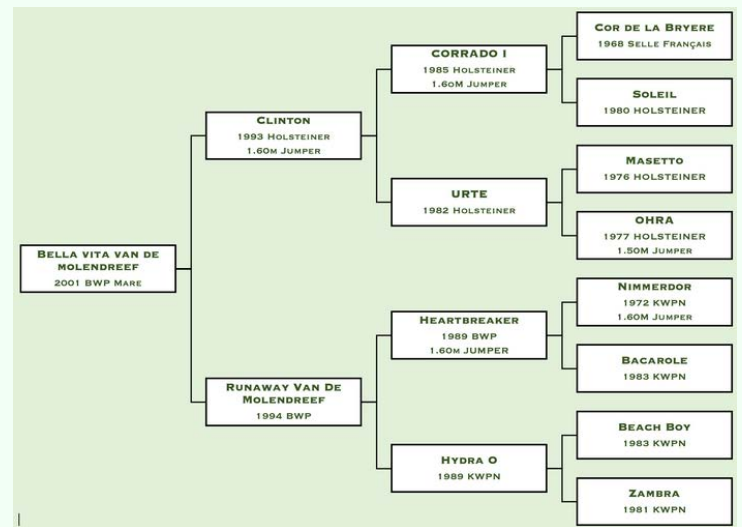
## 2009 Holsteiner Mare

### Verbandsprämie

Beauté de la Vie DKS is a stunning, modern Holsteiner mare by the legendary Cassini I. Beauté is a tall, elegant mare with a lot of blood and endless scope. She suffered a serious injury as a foal, and she never fully recovered. We started her in sport, just to see her natural inclination, scope, carefulness, and attitude. Beauté impressed us with her courage and work ethic, as well as her immense power, but we decided to let her retire to breeding, as her “childhood” injury left some painful scarring and muscle damage. So far, she has produced several foals for us. The first was a remarkably beautiful colt by Darco that was sold at the ESI Auction in Germany for 22 500 euro, Mostar DKS (aka Drago 123). The second was Kasalla DKS, a very chic looking filly born in 2017 and sold at FENCES. Beauté de la Vie lived up to her name again in 2018 and 2019, producing a stunning colt, Ivanin DKS, and an eager, smart filly J’aime la Vie DKS, as well as a true princess in 2020, Kelle Est Belle DKS and an incredibly handsome colt Cozumel DKS in 2021 and a gorgeous filly Mayenne DKS in 2022, following that with a truly adorable colt in 2023 with Krakerjack DKS Z.

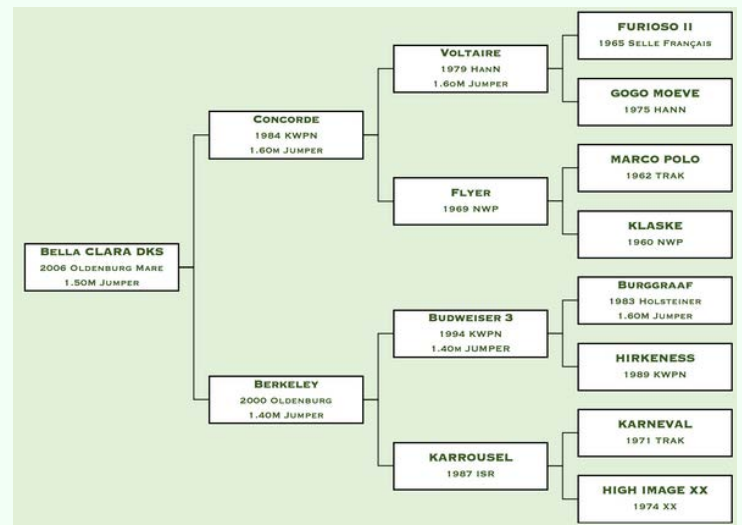
# Bella Vita van de Molendreef DKS (Clinton-Heartbreaker)

2001BWP Mare

**Full sister to the 2011 Horse of the Year in the United States**

Bella Vita van de Molendreef is from one of Belgium's most famous mare lines. Her full sister, Via Volo van de Molendreef, was 2011 Horse of the Year in the United States and competed in the Olympics with Bezie Madden. Another full brother of Bella Vita, Cliff-Hanger van de Molendreef, is a 1.60 m international jumper in Ukraine. And yet another full brother of Bella Vita, Deep Purple van de Molendreef, is an approved stallion and international jumper in Germany. Bella Vita has produced several good foals for her previous owner (including a mare that is owned by Haras des Coudrettes, Carelina Alia, and a 1.40 m jumper, Ubama Alia), and has produced many outstanding foals for us so far. The first was another Nonplusultra Alia colt, Manhattan Quality. The remaining three were each Kannan, and included Nic Nac Quality, born in 2013, who is an approved Zangersheide stallion and is owned by the famous stallion farm Van de Heffinck. That cross was followed up with Kannan colts in 2016, King Quality Z, and 2017, Helios Quality. In 2019, she produced a super-sweet colt, Jamais Sans Moi DKS. In 2022, Bella Vita finally produced not one but TWO fillies, Mademoiselle Fly DKS, from a very consistent son of Galoubet A, as well as Miraculous DKS, a filly by Kashmir van't Schuttershoff.

# Belle Clara DKS (Concorde-Budweiser)

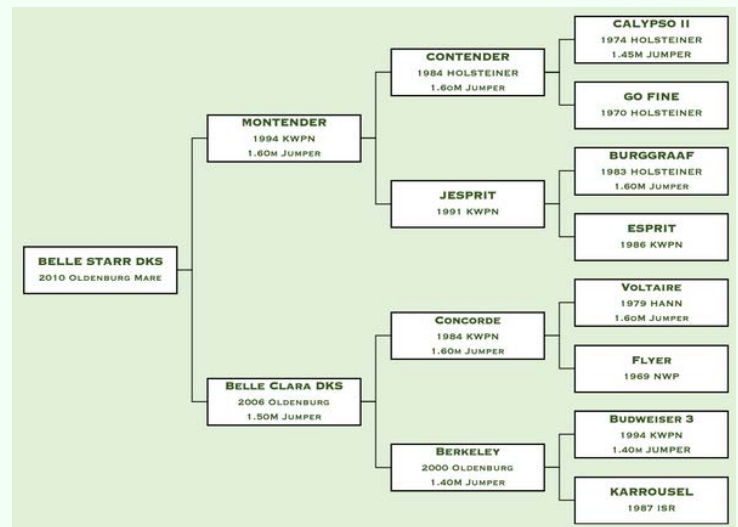

1.50m jumper

**The smartest and bravest horse we've ever owned**

This brave and athletic mare is one of a kind! Beautiful and petite, this mare is all fire when she walks into the show ring. She is super careful and has outstanding technique (which she passes to her offspring). She likes to go fast and she LOVES to win. She has racked up top placings at the World Equestrian Festival, Gulf Coast Winter Circuit, Tryon Equestrian Center, Venice Equestrian Tour, Colorado Horse Park and the list goes on! Belle Clara DKS, affectionately known as "Bagel", competed in her first 1.50 m Grand Prix at age 9 (finishing 2nd!), and she has since been named the Open Jumper Circuit Champion at the Gulf Coast Winter Circuit in 2015 and 2016. She is also a two-time winner of the demanding Jumper Derby at the Gulf Coast Winter Circuit. In 2017, Bagel won the Welcome Stake at the Venice Equestrian Tour and placed in two Grand Prix classes at the 2017 Gulf Coast Winter Circuit. This mare perfectly exemplified our breeding philosophy: Heart. Scope. Mind. We have been experimenting with how best to leverage her skills in breeding, and she has produced foals from three legends: Montender (Belle Starr DKS, who is currently in our breeding program), Verdi TN (Belcanto DKS), and Diamant de Semilly (Jolie Clara DKS, who has been sold to Wioleta Sipak of Poland). In 2020, we branched out to add a new legend, to see what a cross between Belle Clara DKS and Mylord Carthago would produce, and we received in response a very exciting filly Kempten DKS. And in 2021, she produced one of our two Emerald foals, Lil Peche DKS, bringing the proven success of the Diamant de Semilly line back into her list of progeny. In 2022, she welcomed a filly by Winningmood, Merica DKS and in 2023, a colt out of Nimmerdor, Nightclub DKS Z.

# Belle Starr DKS (Montender-Concorde)

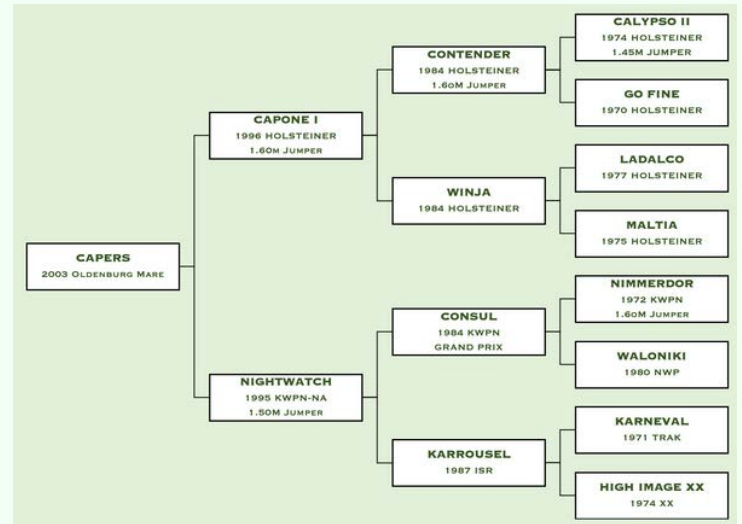
## 2010 Oldenburg Mare

### Dam of Gregory Wathelet's Approved Stallion future star Belgrade DKS

This brave and athletic mare is one of a kind! This stately, beautiful mare is by the Olympic medalist and European Champion, Montender and our superstar Belle Clara DKS. Belle Starr DKS was dedicated to breeding from the start. She is out of our super mare Belle Clara DKS (Concorde-Budweiser), who won a lot up to 1.50m in the USA. Small, compact and ever so quick, she exhibited uncommon bravery and toughness in her sporting career. Very careful and with a great jumping technique, Belle Clara debuted at Grand Prix level as a 9 year old, winning and placing many times, in any company. She was a two-time Gulf Coast Classic Open Jumper Circuit Champion in 2015 and 2016 and also two-time winner of grueling Jumper Derby at the Gulf Coast Winter Classic. A favorite of her owner, Dejan, "Bagel" as he affectionately calls her, retired to a breeding career totally sound and is still one of the best products of DK Sporthorses, exemplifying the breeding philosophy: Heart. Scope. Mind. The father of Belle Starr DKS is the famous Montender (Contender-Burggraaf), a stallion that needs no introduction. It is more than enough to say that, under Marco Kutcher, Montender won two Olympics bronze medals and two European gold medals for Germany.

Belle Starr DKS began producing sporthorses in 2018 with AES licensed stallion Belgrade DKS (Darco-Montender-Concorde) and followed up that impressive cross with a stunning black colt in 2020, Dark Star DKS Z (Douglas VDL-Montender-Concorde). In 2022, she continued her trend of producing flashy colts with Macfly DKS, sired by Mylord Carthago.

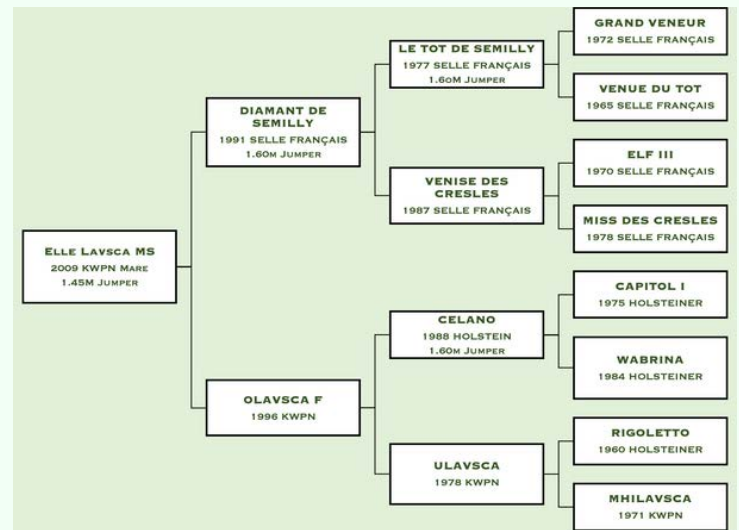


## Capers (Capone I-Consul) 2003 Oldenburg mare

### Dam to 1.60m international jumper Cassini Z

Capers is a 2004 Oldenburg mare (Capone I-Consul) and a recent additions to DK Sporthorses broodmare team. Both her mother Nightwatch and her father Capone I were international 1.50-1.60 jumpers. Capers was never tried in sport, apart from an occasional free jump. Once, when she finished her free jumped line in superb form, she casually trotted up to the 1.70m high arena fence and easily jumped out-in order to join her friends in the field. Dedicated to breeding in a small family operation, Capers has produced four foals so far, including international 1.60 showjumper Cassini Z, who partnered with his rider Darragh Kenny, represented Ireland in Nations cups and recorded wins and placing at the highest level, including at London Olympia, GCT in Madrid and Dublin. Another foal of Capers, Von Carter, in his 1st season, 2019, jumped 7 clears in 10 starts in "Cycle classic" for 4 year old. We are looking forward to what he can do for his new owners! Capers 's dam Nightwatch (Consul-Carneval) competed up to 1.50m, and grandmother Karrousel (Karneval-High Rank XX) produced three 1.50m jumpers, as well as Berkeley, the dam of our own Belle Clara DKS, who recorded many wins and placings at Grand Prix level. Caper's sire, Holstainer stallion Capone I (Contender-Ladalco), was an international 1.60 m showjumper, representing Canada internationally in Nations cups competitions. In 2023, she delivered a filly, Domingo DKS Z.

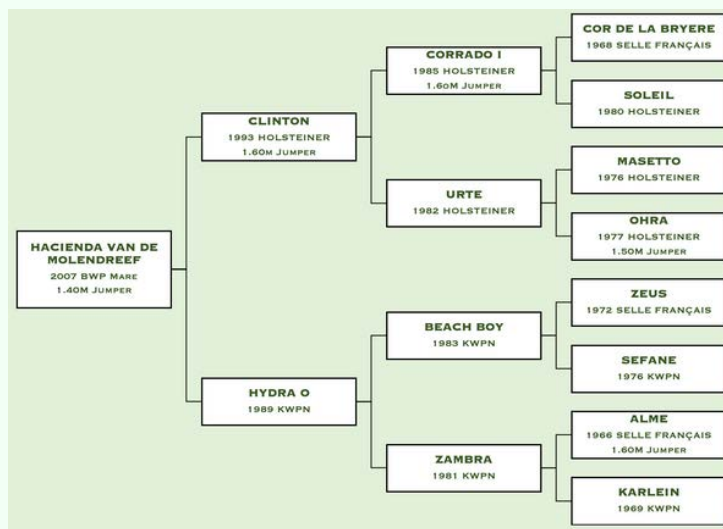

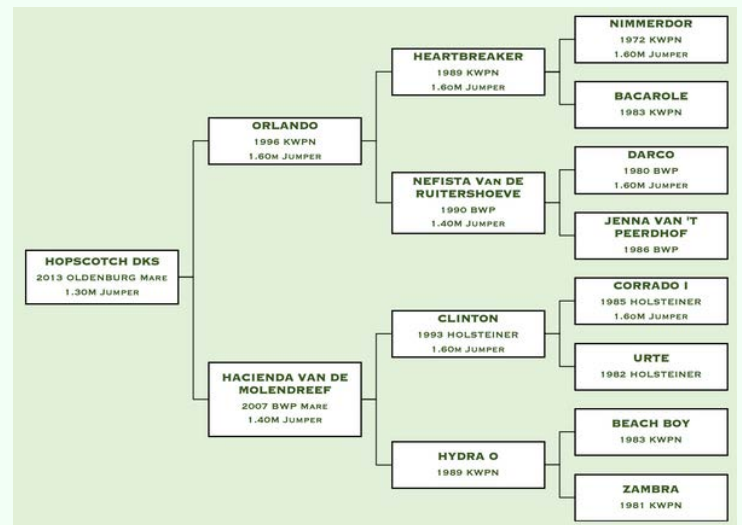


# Hacienda van de Molendreef (Clinton-Beach Boy)

## **Dynamite: Scope, Scope, Scope and Courage**

Hacienda van de Molendreef is our “little dynamite” mare. Hacienda is the favorite of her owner, Dejan Kronic, so she had the unenviable duty of packing him around 1.15-1.20 m courses for several years. Still, she always did it with great courage and attitude, and has not refused a jump in her ENTIRE life! Toward the end of her professional career, Hacienda earned the right to see her potential further developed, so she was superbly ridden by Marlies van Soest and Holly Shepherd over larger courses. Hacienda debuted in the 1.40 m classes in the spring 2017, winning her first class at that height! She went on to compete in the 1.30 m open division at the Gulf Coast Winter Circuit with great success. Afterward, she entered our breeding program fulltime. Her mare line is known for great bravery, and this mare is no exception! She always wanted to work and wanted to fight for her rider. Hacienda’s dam is the famous Hydra O, who is the dam of 6 international jumpers. Hydra is the foundation mare of one of Belgium’s best mare lines. Hydra’s children and grandchildren include international showjumpers such as Beezie Madden’s Olympic mount Via Volo, Darragh Kenny’s Twister, Lauren Hough’s Every Way van der Molendreef, and many more. Hacienda van de Molendreef has produced several foals for us. Beginning in 2013, she produced a filly, Hopscotch DKS (Orlando-Clinton-Beach Boy). In 2019, we welcomed Jiveli DKS (Action-Breaker-Clinton-Beach Boy), and in the 2020 breeding season, we welcomed a Diamant de Semilly foal out of Hacienda van de Molendreef, Kaya DKS. In 2021, Leapfrog DKS joined the team as one of our two Emerald foals for the year, giving Cina an opportunity to showcase a new take on the proven Diamant de Semilly line. In 2022, she continued this trend by producing another Diamant de Semilly, this time a filly, Maggie Mae DKS. In 2023, Cina produced Dracaris DKS, a colt by Dominator.



# Hopscotch DKS (Orlando-Clinton)

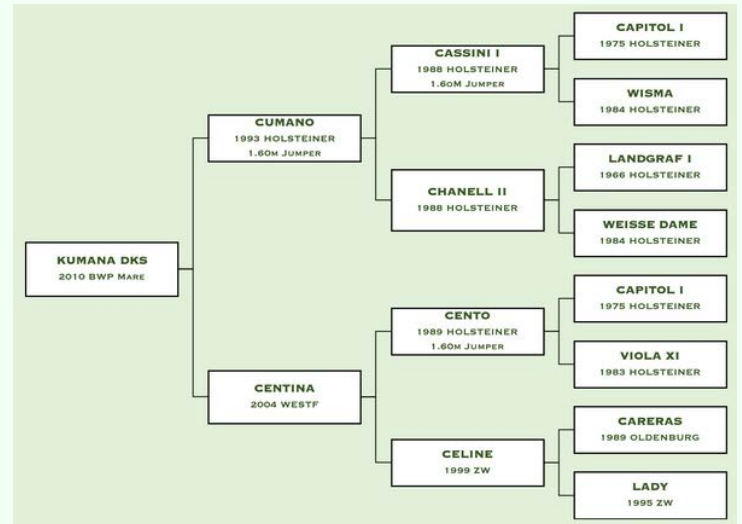

### Elegant modern mare with a huge scope

Hopscotch DKS is a tall, modern, freakishly athletic mare from a famous Belgian mare line that has produced international showjumpers such as Bezie Madden's Via Volo, Darragh Kenny's Twister, Lauren Hough's Every Way van der Molendreef, and many more. Hopscotch has competed successfully up to 1.35m demonstrating a supernatural willingness to do the job with impressive power and excellent jumping technique. Based on that, she entered our breeding program.

Hopscotch is a smart but sensitive mare. Her mare line is known for great bravery, and this mare is not an exception! The mother of Hopscotch is our "little dynamite" mare Hacienda van de Molendreef (Clinton-Beach Boy-Alme). Hacienda's dam is the famous Hydra O, who is the dam of 6 international jumpers. In 2023, Hopscotch welcomed a filly by Diamant de Semilly, Nouveau Diamant DKS.

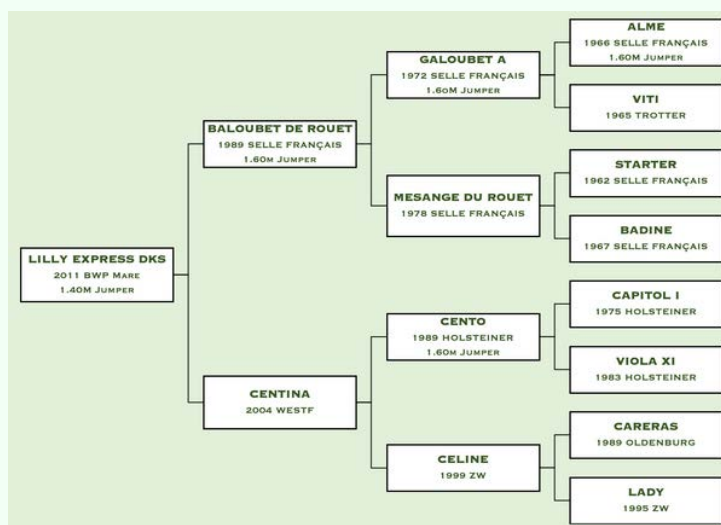
### Dam of 2019 5-year-old Champion of France Ekano DKS

Kumana DKS is a rare breeding mare by the wonderful World Champion Cumano. Kumana was dedicated to breeding from the start, and she has produced several outstanding foals for us so far: Her first foal, a colt by Kannan named Ekano DKS, was sold to none other than the world-famous Haras de Semilly. He became an approved stallion after being crowned Champion of Normandy for 5 year olds in 2019, and winning Champion of France in 2019 at Fontainebleau. We have been so impressed by this pairing, that we have repeated it several times!

Kumana's third foal was Game Boy DKS, also by the World #1 Stallion Diamant de Semilly. Game Boy DKS, a gorgeous youngster with a lot of potential, was sold to the renowned stallion producer Egbert Schep of The Netherlands. In 2017, we welcomed a colt, Hanley DKS (Kannan-Cumano-Cento), who was sold to Gilles Croguennec of Haras Dual, another licensed stallion out of this wonderful mare. In 2018, we welcomed Istok DKS (Nabab de Rêve-Cumano-Cento). We have entered into a partnership with Haras du Semilly for the raising and training of Istok DKS in the coming years. In 2019, we welcomed a filly, Jellybean DKS (Kannan-Cumano-Cento) and in 2020, Kumana produced Kilebo DKS, a very energetic colt. In 2021, we welcomed Lumana DKS, a truly gorgeous filly, and Lincoln DKS, who went to Rachel Tomada and Pénélope Leprevost. In 2022, Kumana produced two foals, Magic Mike DKS, a colt, and Miss Caitlyn DKS, a filly. Again in 2023, Kumana welcomed a filly and a colt, Bellweather DKS and Night King DKS, respectively.

# Lilly Express DKS (Baloubet de Rouet-Cento)

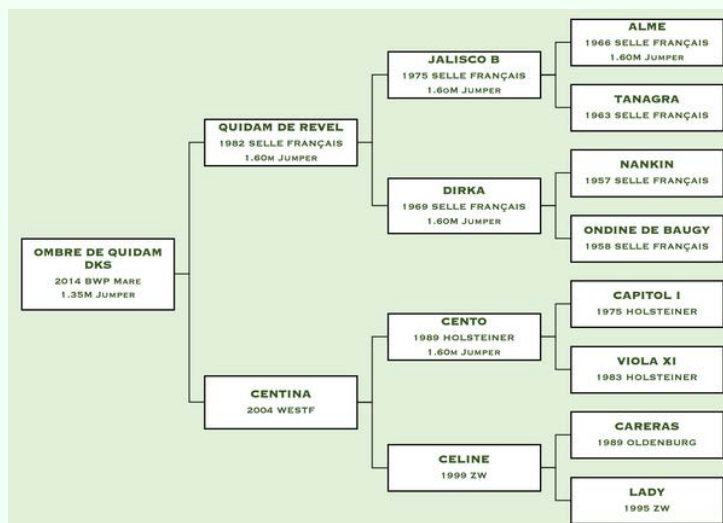

## Speed and Courage

This powerful mare is a prime example of the famous cross of French and German bloodlines. From her Olympic-winner father, Baloubet du Rouet, Lilly has inherited limitless scope and energy: this mare seems tireless! From her mother's side, she inherited Cento's excellent jumping technique and good work ethic. Lilly was carefully started after we used her as ET donor to produce the remarkable Gilly Express DKS. Lilly has been competing since 2016 under Amy Graham, Emmanuel Bertho, Axelle Lagoubie, and Ugrin Stanojević successfully up to 1.4m. Lilly has proved to be super successful, consistently finding herself on the podium, recording wins and placements. This is one VERY scopey horse, seemingly destined for top sport! She is extremely brave and willing. This is a TOP prospect for a serious professional or a patient amateur. She is sweet and friendly and loves being outside, whether in her paddock or going on trail ride. Recently, Lilly produced two colts in 2023, Flareon Express DKS (For Pleasure) and Cobalt Express DKS Z (Chacco-Blue).

# Ombre de Quidam DKS (Quidam de Revel-Cento)

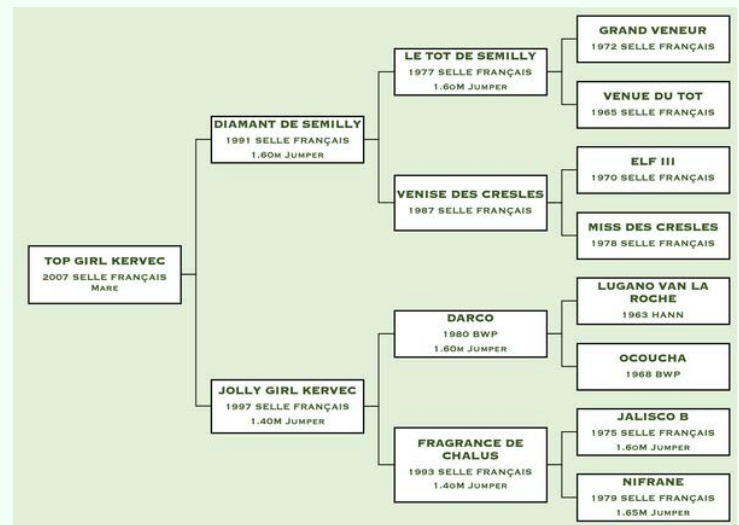

## Beauty and Technique

Ombre de Quidam DKS is Quidam de Revel out of Centina (Cento-Careras), a mare that produced several nice horses for us, including Kumana DKS (Cumano-Cento), the mother of 2019 5 year old Champion of France Ekano DKS (Kannan-Cento), Lilly Express DKS (Baloubet du Rouet-Cento), currently jumping up to 1.40, Nina Simone DKS (Kannan-Cento), jumping internationally up to 1.50m and Mira DKS (Mylord Carthago-Cento), sold to the USA. Ombre herself started competing as a 4 year old in 2018, demonstrating great natural talent for jumping. She continued to successfully jump courses for 5 year old in 2019, after which she took a break to produce an embryo, which became the beautiful colt Katchi Boy DKS. In 2020, she placed 10th overall for six-year olds in the Cycle Classique, a national series of progressively difficult courses for her age group. Jumping up to 1.35m now, she is showing a lot of enthusiasm and scope.

She is by Quidam de Revel (Jalisco B-Nankin), a horse that with Herve Godignon won a team bronze medal at Olympic Games in Barcelona 1992 for France and took an individual fourth place. He also scored dozens of other high profile wins and placings, including in NC, WC. As a sire he spent many years in the top 10 of WBFHS rankings list, as he produced many successful horses. Some of them are known as great stallions themselves, such as Nabab de Reve, Dollar de la Pierre, Guidam; and others medal winning Championship horses, like Maikel van der Vleuten's VDL Groep Verdi, team Olympic Vice-champion from 2012; Jerome Guery's European team Champion 2019 Quel Homme de Hus and Philippe Rozier's Rahotep de Toscane, team Olympic Champion from 2016. In 2023, Ombre welcomed a colt by Kannan, Nunchuck Norris DKS.

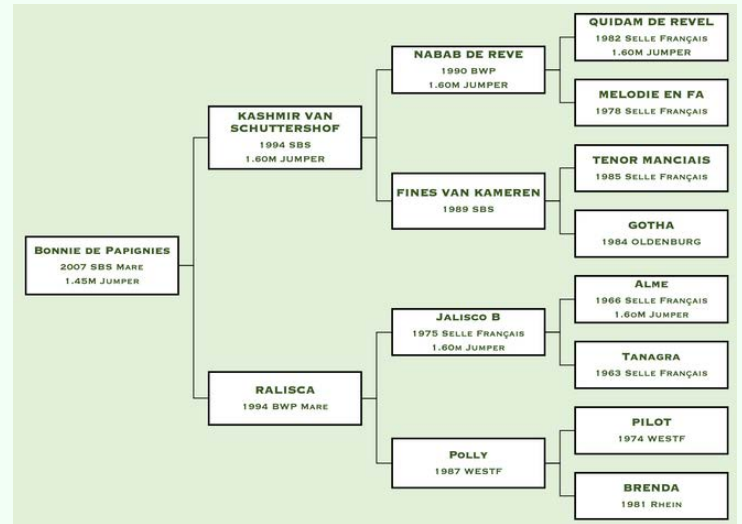


# Top Girl Kervec DKS (Diamant de Semilly-Darco) 2007 Selle Français Mare

## From the best mare line in France

Top Girl Kervec is from a famous breeding family. Top Girl has no fewer than 5 brothers who are approved stallions (including 3 full brothers). Top Girl's full sister Queen Girl Kervec competed in the Nations Cups for France (including at Hickstead) and has produced several offspring, including international 1.6m horse Trafalgar Kervec who has jumped successfully with many riders, mostly recently including Margaux Rocuet, and Vip du Forezan, the 2016 Champion of France for 7-year-olds at Fontainebleau.

Top Girl Kervec has produced many wonderful foals for us. In 2015, we welcomed Funny Girl DKS (Kannan) which was sold to Greg Burrow of Beebee, Arkansas. In 2017, we had two foals via embryo transfer born in the United States. One, Hollywood Girl DKS by Baloubet de Rouet, was sold to Wioleta Sipak of Poland. The other, Highlander DKS was sold to Greg Burrow of Beebee, Arkansas. In 2019, we again welcomed two foals from Top Girl Kervec: Jolie Girl DKS by Ekano DKS\*Semilly was an opportunity for us to use a newly approved stallion who was produced by our breeding program. Ekano DKS\*Semilly (Kannan-Cumano-Cento) became an approved stallion under the care and training of Richard and Sophie Levallois of Haras du Semilly, joining the ranks of their other stallions such as Diamant de Semilly. Ekano DKS\*Semilly was champion of France for five year olds in 2019, and won Champion of Normandy the year before. In 2019, Jalisco DKS is by Quidam de Revel. In 2020 we welcomed Karisma DKS, a stunning filly sold to Bertille Millet. In 2021, Top Girl again lived up to her name by producing two spectacular foals: Kamikaze de Pao Z from Kashmir van't Schuttershof and Lepa Girl DKS from Baloubet de Rouet. In 2022, we again welcomed two stunning foals: Miki Milan DKS, again by Baloubet de Rouet, and Mighty Girl DKS, a filly by Quaprice Bois Margot. In 2023, Top Girl gave us Mylady Fragrance, by Mylord Carthago.



# Bonnie de Papignies

## (Kashmir van't Schuttershof-Jalisco B)

### 2007 Selle Français Mare

National Champion of Serbia 2020, 2022

Bonnie des Papignies (Kashmir van't Schuttershof-Jalisco B) was two times National Champion of Serbia (2020 and 2022), two times vice-champion (2017 and 2018) and a prolific winner in national and regional classes up to 1.45m. With her rider and trainer Stefan Djokovic in the saddle, this 2007 mare was a regular team member for Serbian national team, representing her country at two Balkan Championships. She is by Kashmir van't Schuttershof, one of the most popular breeding stallions of today, out of Ralisca (Jalisco B-Pilot), who produced two other 1.45m horses. Bonnie's dam line gave several 1.50 and 1.60 horses, including Oto Beckers approved stallion Grandilot (Grandeur-Pilot), NC horse for Germany and Piet Raijmakers approved stallion Van Schijndel's Rascin (Ramiro Z-Pilot), NC horse for Holland. Throughout her career Bonnie demonstrated the desire to get the job done, often performing against the odds. Her durability, bravery and consistency more than qualify her for our breeding program.

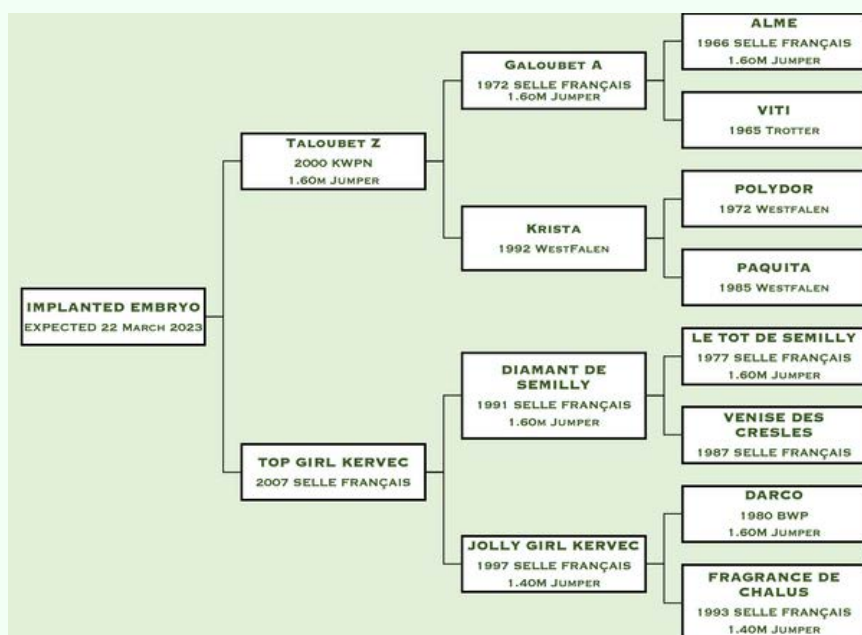


# Taloubet Z-Diamant de Semilly-Darco

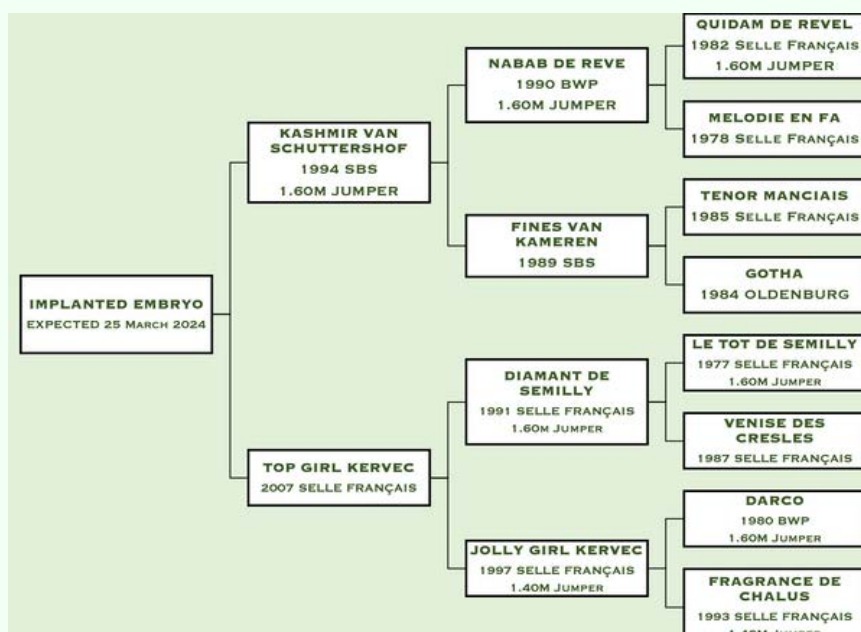
# Kashmir van Schuttershof-Diamant de Semilly-Darco

## SOLD

Kashmir van't Schuttershof is one of the best sons of Nabab de Rêve, and like his sire proved himself as a competition horse before starring as a jumping sire. Kashmir brings technique, force, reflexes, size, but most off all he brings super mentality. The progeny of Kashmir are always willing to work, have a big heart, enough blood but not too hot. As a breeding stallion, Kashmir has already produced 60 approved sires and some very fancy competitors, notably 2/3 of the Olympic team gold medalists from Tokyo 2020: H&M All In and H&M Indiana.

Top Girl Kervec is from a famous breeding family. Top Girl has no fewer than 5 brothers who are approved stallions (including 3 full bothers). Top Girl's full sister Queen Girl Kervec competed in the Nations Cups for France (including at Hickstead) and has produced several offspring, including international 1.6m horse Trafalgar Kervec who has jumped successfully with many riders, mostly recently including Margaux Rocuet, and Vip du Forezan, the 2016 Champion of France for 7-year-olds at Fontainebleau.



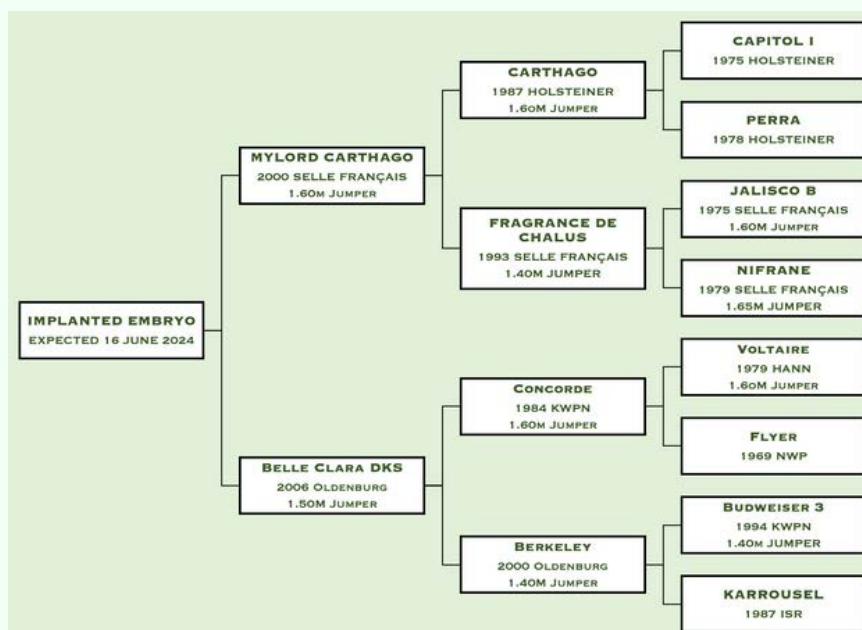


# Cumano Alpha Z-Concorde-Budweiser

He also scored dozens of other high profile wins and placings, including in NC, WC. As a sire he spent many years in the top 10 of WBFHS rankings list, as he produced many successful horses. Some of them are known as great stallions themselves, such as Nabab de Reve, Dollar de la Pierre, Guidam; and others medal winning Championship horses, like Maikel van der Vleuten's VDL Groep Verdi, team Olympic Vice-champion from 2012; Jerome Guery's European team Champion 2019 Quel Homme de Hus and Philippe Rozier's Rahotep de Toscane, team Olympic Champion from 2016.

**Collaborations with other breeders has allowed us to add the following exciting mare-lines to our breeding program.**

Charlotte Z (Calvino Z-L'Amour Z) is a Zangersheide mare by Calvino Z (Calvin Z -Ramiro Z), who from just over 200 foals sired, produced 12 approved sons and 15 horses jumping 1.50+. Charlotte Z is out of Life Style Z (L'Amour Z -Ramiro Z), who produced two 1.60 and four 1.40+ horses, while the granddam Roxan Z (Ramiro Z-Alme Z) produced three approved stallions. The dam line goes back to Argentina Z, the mother of legendary Ratina Z. Charlotte Z follows in the footsteps of this damline: out of six foals older than 6 (in 2022) she produced one 1.50 horse and a licensed stallion, Important Style VK (Falaise de Muze) and a 1.45 horse, Floyd W (Bernini), while her daughter Britt W (AD Unaniem) produced 1.60m International jumper, Gemma W (Luidam).



Dark Chocolate Maxx (Darco-Chin Chin) is a powerful 2013 daughter of legendary Darco, known as one of the best dam sires. Her mother is by Chin Chin, out of Quidam de Revel mare and there are many useful jumpers in that mareline, including some 1.60 horses. She has produced several fine foals, among them one stallion licensed for OS and Hann, Cornets Darco (Cornet Obolensky-Darco). He was so impressive during his licensing that he was promptly bought by Paul Schockemöhle!



Nikita de la Vie (Nabab de Reve-Heartbreaker) comes from a famous mare line. Her mother produced three 1.60m horses and two approved stallions. Nikita's sire is one of those horses that achieved greatness both in and out of the ring. Not only has he won Bronze team medal for Belgium at WEG 2002 with Phillippe le Jeune in the saddle, but with the same rider his son Vigo d'Arsouilles was crowned individual champion at WEG 2010 and his other son, London, was vice-champion at London Olympics 2012. Born in 2015, Nikita de la Vie was jumped only as a 5 year old, which she did in good style and has produced two great looking foals in 2022.
